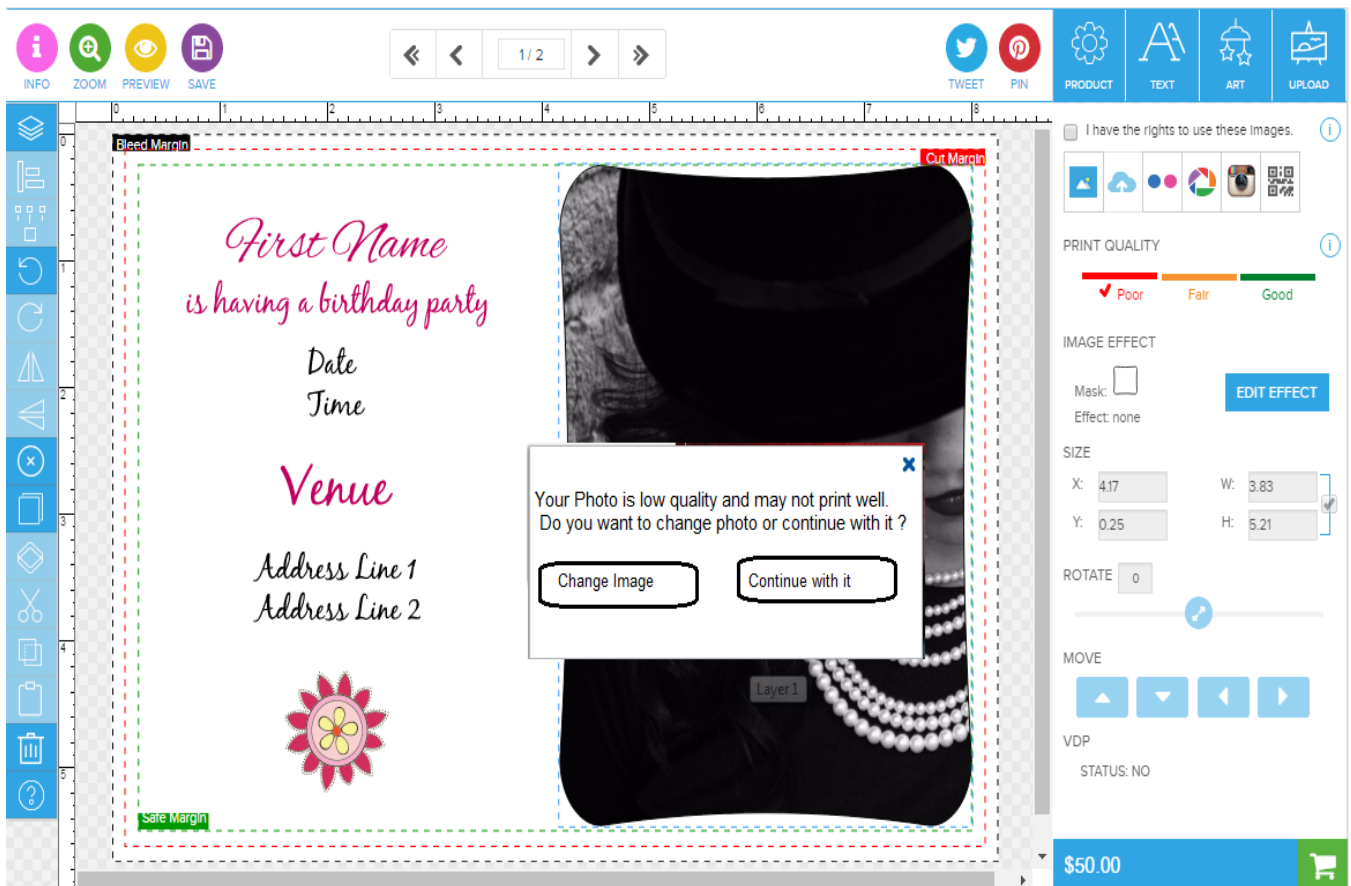
4. Customizations

The following set of feature customizations is considered with respect of our turnkey All in One Designer HTML5 Corporate Edition V2.5.1 functionality.

Frontend Customization in Designer studio

1. Image Quality Popup for uploaded image

- It will show a pop up of whether the image quality of uploaded image is good or not.
- Users will be able to either change the image or continue with the same image
- Image quality will be defined based on pixels or size of the image. Admin can define the minimum requirement of image in pixels or size globally at the backend.
- Content of the Pop up can be managed by admin (Only Text).



2. Valid Image formats to upload

- Users will be able to upload image in these formats in designer studio and quick edit - .psd, .pdf, .ai, .eps, .tif, .tiff, .psd, .jpg, .jpeg and .png.

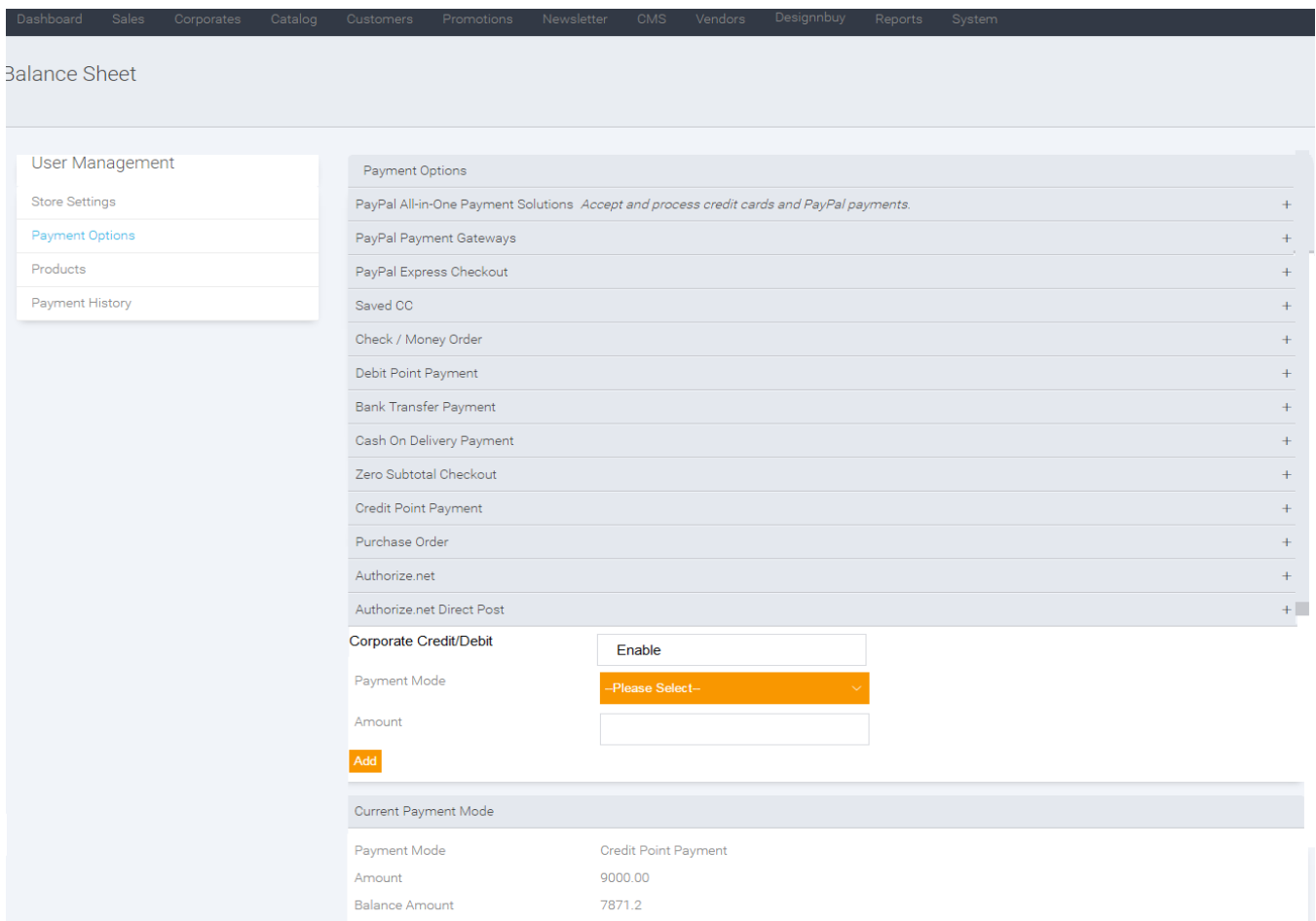
3. Corporate B2B store home page

- All users can see home page and product listing page of each category without registration or logged-in. To go on a product detail page and see details of a product user need to make login or registration.

5. Admin Panel Customization

1. Extended Payment Methods for Corporate Stores

- While creating corporate store super admin can allow multiple payment option for corporate store users.



- Super admin has to configure payment methods in main admin panel area which can be available to corporate stores also.

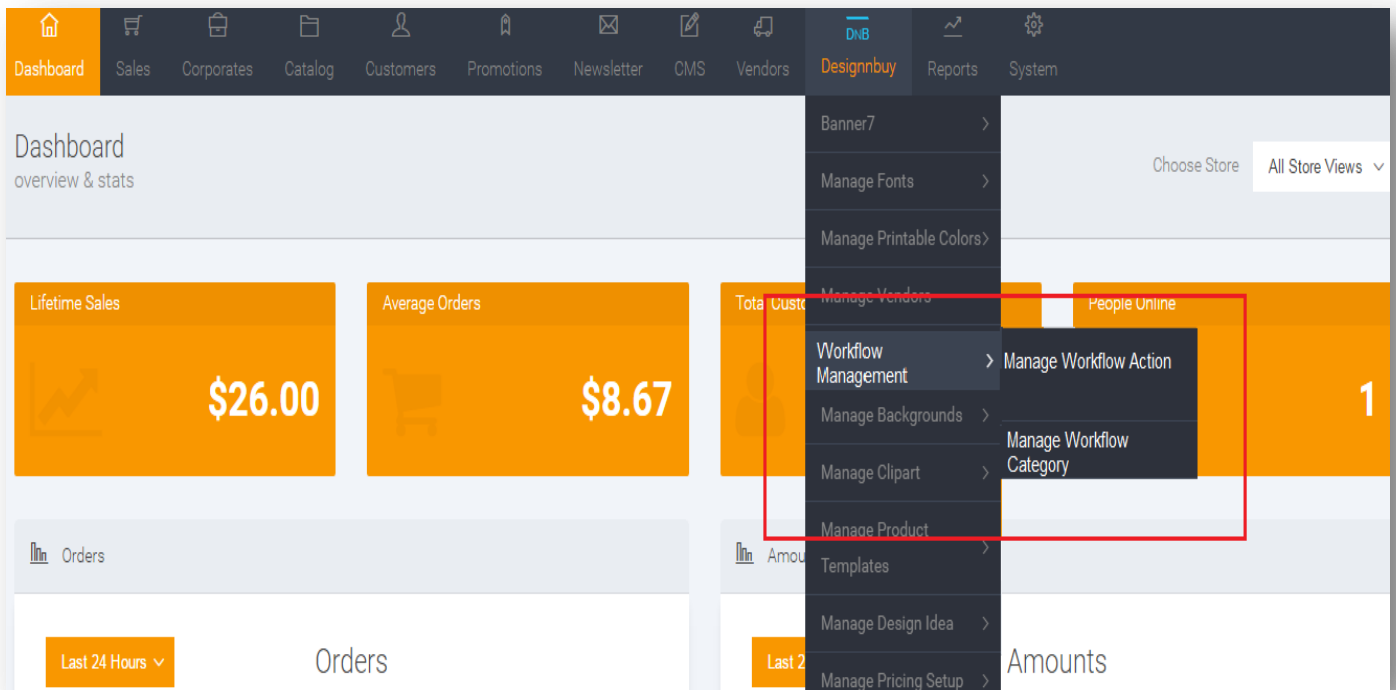
- While creating corporate store it will show all available payment methods and admin can assign multiple payment methods to corporate stores.

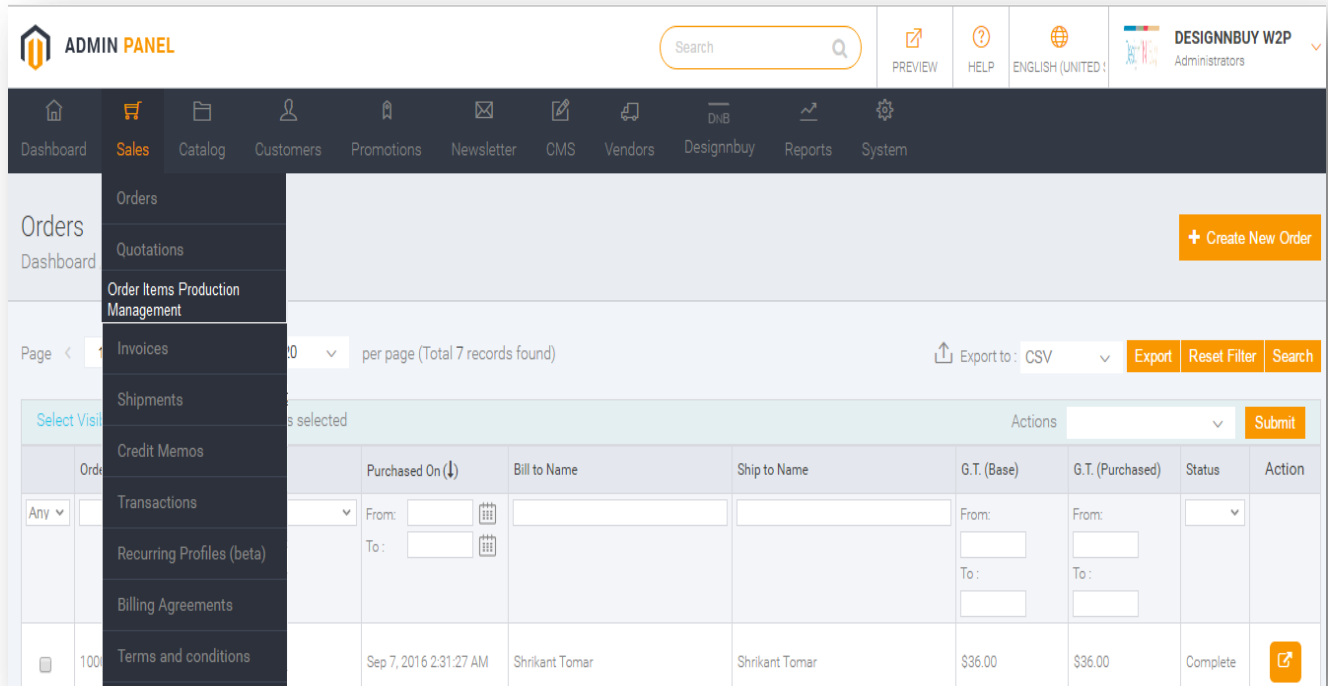

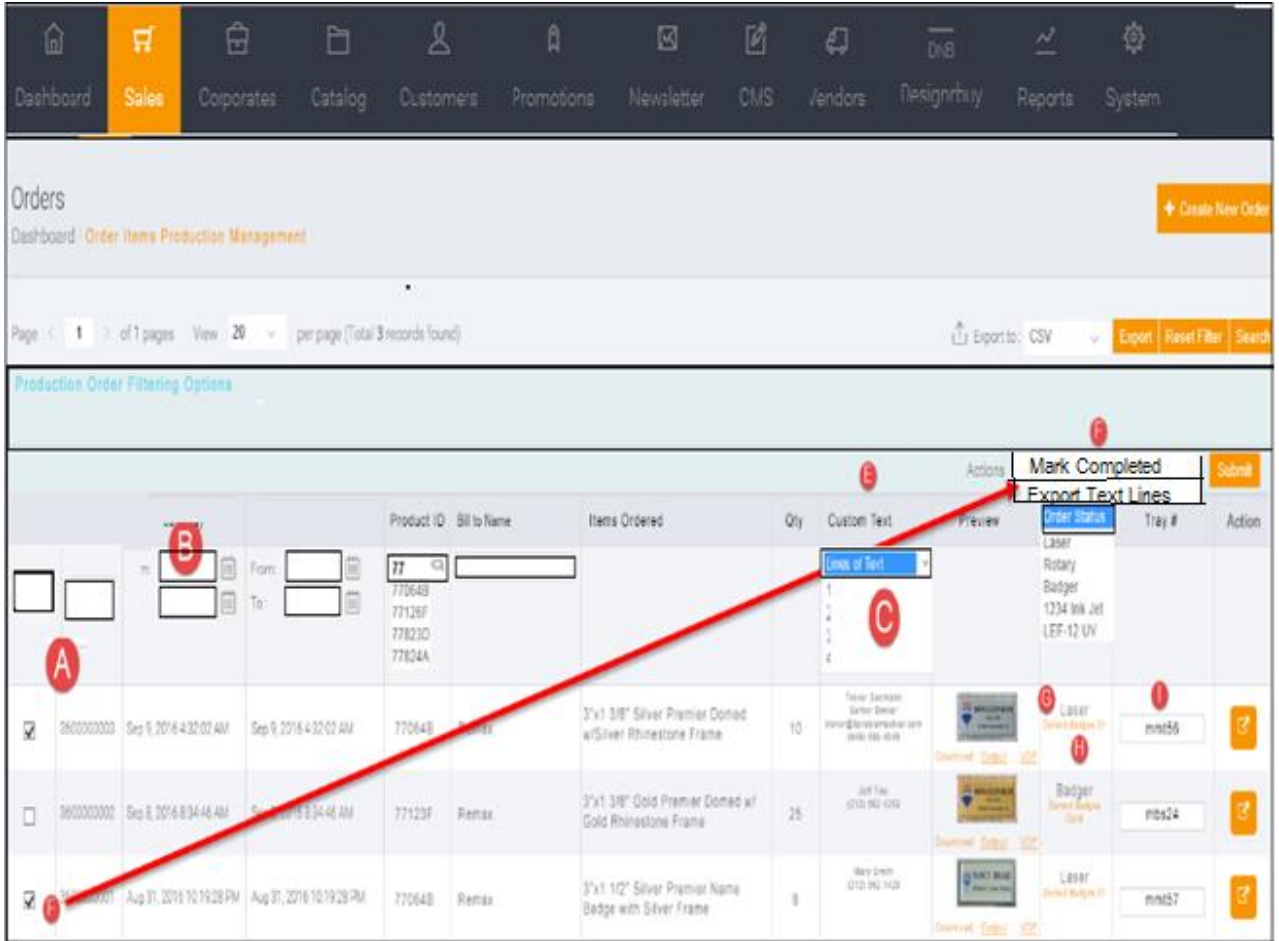
3. Order Items Management

- In Order section there would be custom modules of 'Order Items Production Management.'



- Using this module admin can see all ordered items separately to manage their custom status (Assign to the product using manage workflow category)
- Admin can see the following details in Order Items Management Grid :
 1. Check Box
 2. Order ID
 3. Purchase From Store (with Filter as dropdown of store listing)
 4. Purchase Date (with filter of calendar from – to date)
 5. Delivery Date (with filter of calendar from – to date)
 6. Product ID (Admin can filter using search box with predictive search filter)
 7. Bill To name
 8. Item Ordered Details (Default)
 9. Qty
 10. Custom text lines – Admin can see text lines added/edit by user on a template and filter using no. of lines available in the design
 11. Preview of design (with the like to download PDF, VDP)
 12. Status (With filter as dropdown of custom action added from manage workflow action)
 13. Tray ID (with filter of search box)
 14. Edit Option
 15. Admin can select multiple items and mark them as completed and Export Customized text lines in .csv.

Order Item Edit Options

- We want to add a new option to this drop down that allows the admins the ability to export the contents in the custom text column to a csv file. Curl should be always “On” on the server

Latest php version – PHP 5.5 and MySQL (LAMP Stack)

We provide the facility to get the output file in both the format – SVG and PDF. To generate the PDF output from the SVG, we have used the INKSCAPE server side application. So, INKSCAPE should be installed on your server. **It is free software.** Please refer below link to download INKSCAPE. We are also sending you the PDF document for the INKSCAPE installation for your reference. Please do not worry about it, our technical team will guide you for it. To Generate PDF in CMYK ghostscript should be installed on the server.
